

FTT GLOBAL PRIVACY POLICY

FTT Global Limited (**We**) are committed to protecting and respecting your privacy. This policy (together with our terms of use) www.fttglobal.com/web_terms.doc sets out the basis on which any personal data we collect from you, or that you provide to us, will be processed by us. Please read the following carefully to understand our views and practices regarding your personal data and how we will treat it.

For the purpose of the Data Protection Act 1998 (the **Act**), the data controller is FTT Global Limited of 145-157 Saint John Street, London EC1V 4PY.

Information we may collect from you

We may collect and process the following data about you:

- Information that you provide by filling in forms on our site fttglobal.com (**our site**). This includes information provided at the time of registering to use our site, subscribing to our service or requesting further services.
- If you contact us, we may keep a record of that correspondence.
- Details of transactions you carry out through our site and of the fulfilment of your orders.

IP addresses and cookies

We may collect information about your computer, including where available your IP address, operating system and browser type, for system administration. This is statistical data about our users' browsing actions and patterns, and does not identify any individual.

For the same reason, we may obtain information about your general internet usage by using a cookie file which is stored on the hard drive of your computer. Cookies contain information that is transferred to your computer's hard drive. They help us to improve our site and to deliver a better and more personalised service.

You may refuse to accept cookies by activating the setting on your browser which allows you to refuse the setting of cookies. However, if you select this setting you may be unable to access certain parts of our site. Unless you have adjusted your browser setting so that it will refuse cookies, our system will issue cookies when you log on to our site.

Where we store your personal data

If needed, the data that we collect from you may be transferred to, and stored at, a destination outside the European Economic Area (**EEA**). We will take all steps reasonably necessary to ensure that your data is treated securely and in accordance with this privacy policy.

Where we have given you (or where you have chosen) a pin number or other password which enables you to access certain parts of our site, you are responsible for keeping this password confidential. We ask you not to share a pin number or other password with anyone.

All communications between your computer and us is encrypted using 128 bit encryption algorithm. Once we have received your information, we will use strict procedures and security features to try to prevent unauthorised access.

Uses made of the information

We use information held about you in the following ways:

- To provide you with information, products or services that you request from us or which we feel may interest you, where you have consented to be contacted for such purposes.
- To carry out our obligations arising from any contracts entered into between you and us.
- To notify you about changes to our service.

We may also use your data, or permit selected third parties to use your data, to provide you with information about goods and services which may be of interest to you.

If you do not want us to use your data in this way, or to pass your details on to third parties for marketing purposes, please tick the relevant box situated on the form on which we collect your data.

Disclosure of your information

We may disclose your personal information to third parties:

- In the event that we sell or buy any business or assets, in which case we may disclose your personal data to the prospective seller or buyer of such business or assets.
- If we are under a duty to disclose or share your personal data in order to comply with any legal obligation, or in order to enforce or apply our terms of use www.fttglobal.com/web_terms.doc or terms and conditions of business www.fttglobal.com/business_terms.doc or to protect the rights, property, or safety of FTT Global Limited, our customers, or others. This includes exchanging information with other companies and organisations for the purposes of fraud protection and credit risk reduction.
